




The Golden Knights also captured their **sixth** consecutive New York Collegiate Athletic Conference Championship, were the nation's top-ranked team for most of the season, and outscored their opponents by an average of 28.9 points.

# 2000 Baseball Team

The 2000 baseball team advanced to the **NCAA Division II World Series** in Montgomery, Alabama.

The Golden Knights finished 32-16-1 overall, overcoming being the first team eliminated in the New York Collegiate Athletic Conference Tournament by rebounding to win three consecutive games to capture the NCAA Northeast Regional Championship at UMass Lowell despite entering the weekend as the fourth and final seed.

**Saint Rose** lost to Indianapolis and eventual champion Southeastern Oklahoma State in the World Series, but its appearance firmly entrenched the program on the national landscape.
